Re: Proposed Firenze Plaza

Dear Mr. Miller:

We have copied you on our letter to Mayor de Weerd protesting the fact that the Firenze Plaza developers, The Land Group, are proposing to use four residential streets in the Tuscany Development to solve their issue with the existing arterial roadways, Eagle and Amity, being unable to handle the increase in traffic of a mixed-use development on the NW corner of the intersection of those roads.

We are very worried about the safety of the children who live and play in Tuscany, if this proposal is approved. The additional traffic through the development increases risk for the children, and if a way cannot be found to rectify the risk to our children, then we would ask you to withdraw Albertson's support of the project.

We understand that the heirs/owners of the property in question have been trying to sell it since 2008, but they want too much money to make it profitable for a residential builder to purchase the land and develop the low-density housing for which the property is currently zoned. We do not want our children to be put at risk for their greed, and the greed of those who would attempt to push the Firenze Plaza project through at any cost.
